The Associate of Arts in History (AA in History) is designed to provide foundational knowledge of western civilization, United States History, and the history of diverse groups, and to prepare students to transfer to a baccalaureate program in History. While the major is primarily dedicated to preparing students for transfer to a 4-year institution, an AA in History can prepare graduates for jobs as an archivist, curatorial assistant, library assistant, legal assistant, tour guide, or research assistant.

- Analyze how the interplay of multiple factors in a society including intellectual, economic, demographic, and cultural variables resulted in particular historical outcomes.
- Describe how the social, political, intellectual, and economic systems of a particular society change over time.
